## No Kid Hungry's Impact in Maine

No Kid Hungry and our partners, like Preble Street, are ending childhood hunger in Maine. With support from No Kid Hungry, Preble Street was able to help qualify Windham as a meal site. This allowed them to serve summer meals in this high-need neighborhood. The next step was locating a meal site. After running into many dead ends, something very special happened. A local



senior housing unit, Little Falls Landing, agreed to open up their backyard to the community. Many residents volunteered to help serve summer meals. The volunteers got to know all of the children by name and many seniors came out to the site everyday, even when not signed up to volunteer. Summer was once a season of hunger for kids in Windham and across Maine, but we're changing that. By investing in practical solutions that connect children to food, we ensure the summer months are no longer a time of uncertainty for kids.
